### MORNING HIGH TEA NATIONAL GOSSIP DAY SATURDAY, AUGUST 6 AT 9:30 AM

Celebrate National Gossip Day properly, with a delicious *cuppa* (that's slang for "cup of tea") and some yummy breakfast goodies! Let's drink to this special day of Gossip in true Bridgerton style - on the Rooftop!



August 6, 1881, was the birthday of celebrated and syndicated Hollywood gossip columnist Louella Parsons. Her first movie column, the first of its kind anywhere in the

country, debuted in 1914 in the *Chicago Record-Herald*. William Randolph Hearst bought the paper in 1918, and didn't care for the column, so he shut it down. Parsons then moved to New York, and brought back the movie column in the New York Morning Telegraph; however, Hearst began to warm up to her work (after championing Hearst's mistress Marion Davies), and she joined one of his newspapers, the New York American, in 1922.

After a bout with tuberculosis in 1925 that almost claimed her life, she moved to Beverly Hills, where she unofficially became the "Queen of Hollywood gossip" until her nemesis and fierce rival, Hedda Hopper, arrived in town. Parson's writing style was more chatty, often described as more "sweetness and light" or "gooey", whereas Hopper's style took on a more crass tone.

Parsons considered the biggest scoop of her career to be the divorce of Douglas Fairbanks Sr. and Mary Pickford who were the most famous couple in Hollywood at the time.



Congratulations are in order for Teea and may we be blessed with many more successful years together!



## Gazing into the Heavens PERSEIDS METEOR SHOWER ( EDUCATION HOUR

FRIDAY, AUGUST 12 AT 11:00 AM

he Perseids meteor shower is associated with the

comet Swift-Tuttle. The meteors really are made of tiny space debris from the Swift-Tuttle, and are one of the brighter meteor showers of the year. They are called the "Perseids" because the radiant point from which they appear lies in the constellation Perseus. Astronomers and stargazers alike both flock to watch this particular meteor shower because at its peak (between August 9 and 13) from a dark place, you can see 60 to 100 meteors within an hour from a dark place.

Learn all about these colorful meteors that are perhaps the most beloved meteor shower in the Northern Hemisphere.


