


RESIDENT SPOTLIGHT CAROL M.



The High Holy Days actually began with the Jewish New Year, Rosh Hashanah, back in September 2022, and are followed by the Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur), Sukkot, Shemini Atzeret, and ends with the holiday of Simchat Torah.

Lucy Day, and throughout this month we will celebrate this American actress, comedienne, and producer! She was nominated for 13 Primetime Emmy Awards, winning five times. In the 1940s, she met Cuban bandleader Desi Arnaz, Jr., and they eloped in November 1940. In the 1950s, Ball and her husband created the popular sitcom *I Love Lucy*. Lucy and Desi later divorced in March 1960, after which, she married comedian Gary Morton in 1961. Ball also became the first woman to run a major television studio, Desilu Productions, which also produced two very well-known series, *Mission Impossible* and *Star Trek*.

FAREWELL TO THE QUEEN

QUEEN ELIZABETH II (1926 TO 2022)

After living a long and very consequential life, Queen Elizabeth II passed away at the age of 96. Having pledged



that her "whole life, whether it be long or short, shall be devoted to your service and the service of our great imperial family to which we all belong." Elizabeth Windsor was sometimes referred to as the "Servant Queen." Across the globe, the world pays tribute to this incredible woman, reflecting on the historic sweep of her reign, as she presided over Britain's colonial empire and eventually, embraced the independence of England's former dominions.

In London at Westminster Hall, a mile's long throng of thousands queued up to offer their deep respect and to see their beloved Queen for one final time. The Queen was buried at St. George's Chapel at Windsor Castle alongside her beloved husband, Prince Phillip, and her father, King George VI, and her mother, Queen Elizabeth The Queen Mother, and her younger sister, Princess Margaret.

Synonymous with Britain itself, and its longest-reigning monarch (seven decades!), we will all miss this unassuming and hardworking Queen. As we mourn, our grief may also likely be colored by the notion that Queen Elizabeth also represents the passage of time in our own lives.
