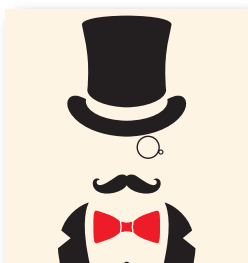

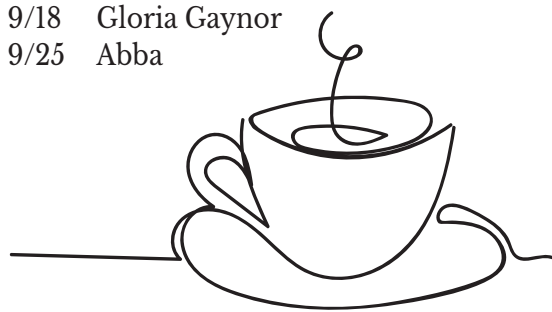

Join us for coffee on Sundays, as we feature and appreciate the music of four of top Disco artists.

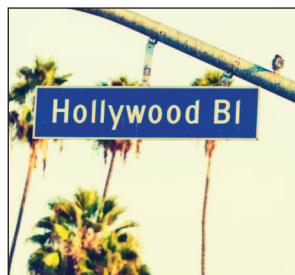

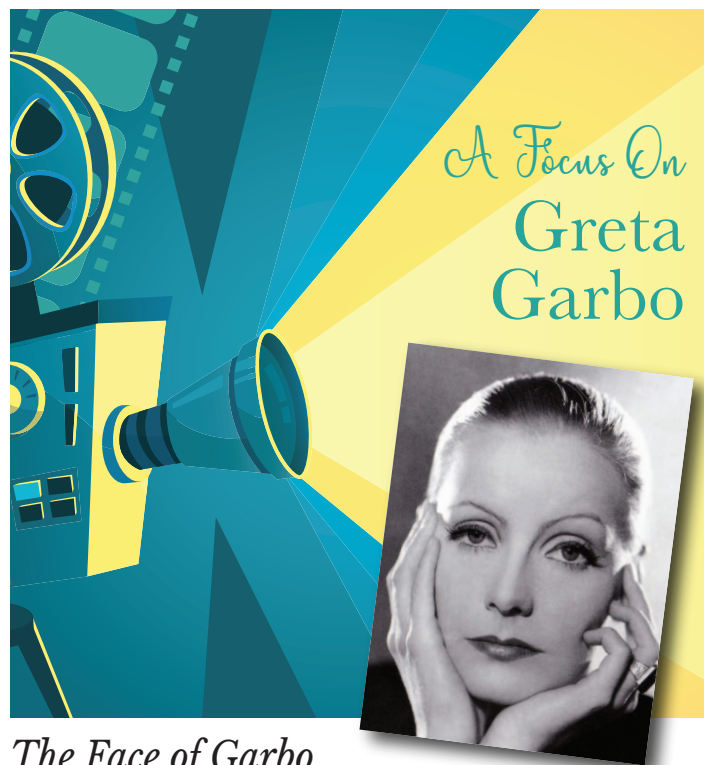

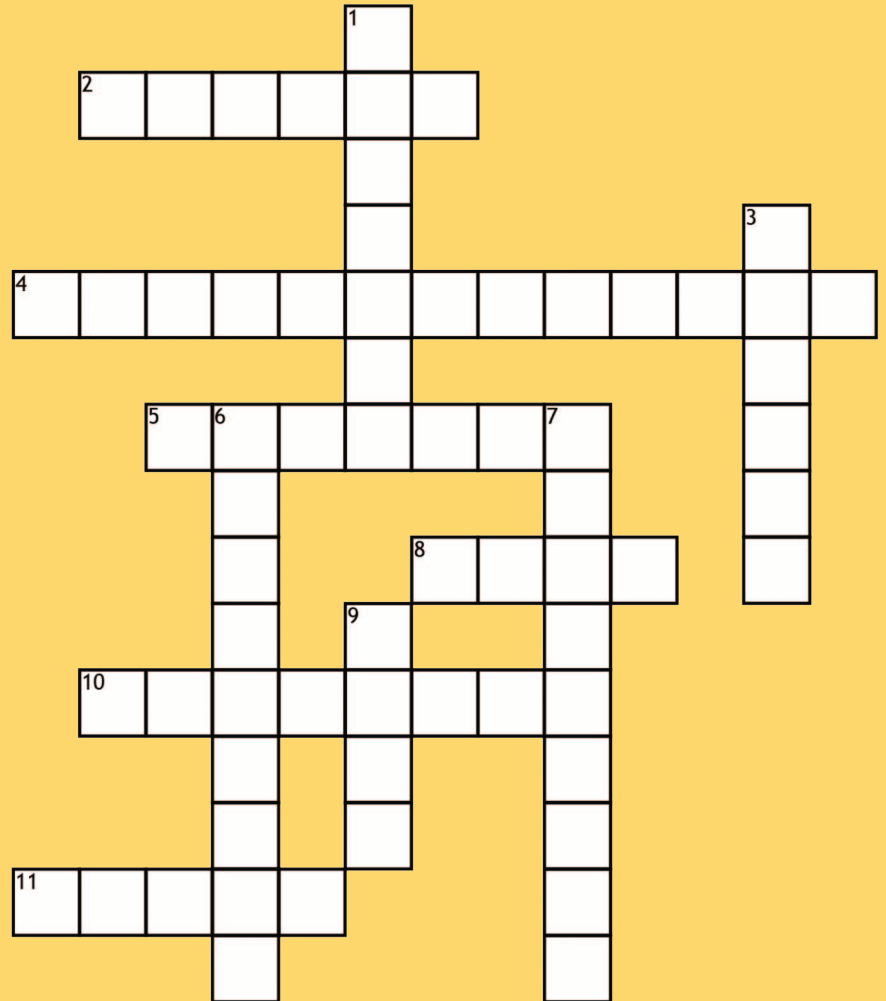
